

CHILD AMBASSADOR CHECKLIST

Use the following Checklist to make sure you have submitted all of the appropriate supporting data correctly and within the designated timeframes.

Any Submission that has not followed the guidelines and timeframes will not be considered.

- The nomination must be made by a MSHA Member
- Nominations and Supporting Data can be submitted from **DECEMBER 1 UNTIL DECEMBER 31**
- The nomination and supporting data will be submitted on-line
 - The nomination form is on the MSHA Website (showmemsha.org)
 - The supporting data is emailed to mshaawards@gmail.com
- The nominee must be at least 3 years of age
- The nominee can be from outpatient, inpatient, school, or home setting
- The nominee must present a significant hearing, speech, and/or language problem as documented by an Audiologist and/or Speech Language Pathologist
- The nominee must be able to attend and accept recognition at the MSHA Convention
- The nominee may be asked to make other public appearances
- The nominee, the family and/or caregiver must write a maximum 500 word statement of explanation on how their Audiologist and/or Speech Language Pathologist participated in improving their communication ability

The following supportive data can be submitted anytime between **DECEMBER 1 UNTIL DECEMBER 31.**
